## Intex PlasterX® Paper Joint Tape

## **1. Identification**

## **Product Details:**

5PT20S, 5PT75S, 5PT150S
10rolls/20rolls/60rolls
Paper reinforcing tape for strengthening and finishing joints of interior drywall panels. A center creasing process allows easy folding for use at corners.
Make sure that the surface to work on is clean (no dust nor grease). First apply a liberal coat of joint compound, about 2 to 3 wide along the entire joint. Throw away any compound that has dried pieces. While the compound is still wet, embed our paper joint tape by centering the tape directly over the joint. Use a taping knife to press the tape into the joint compound. Remove excess compound over and around the tape to level the surface. Apply a second coat of joint compound that extends beyond the first coat 7 to 8. Let it dry completely. Apply a thin finishing coat to each joint. Once all dried sand lightly with a fine abrasive.
Not recommended for areas exposed to sustained temperatures over 50°C
